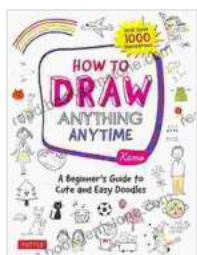

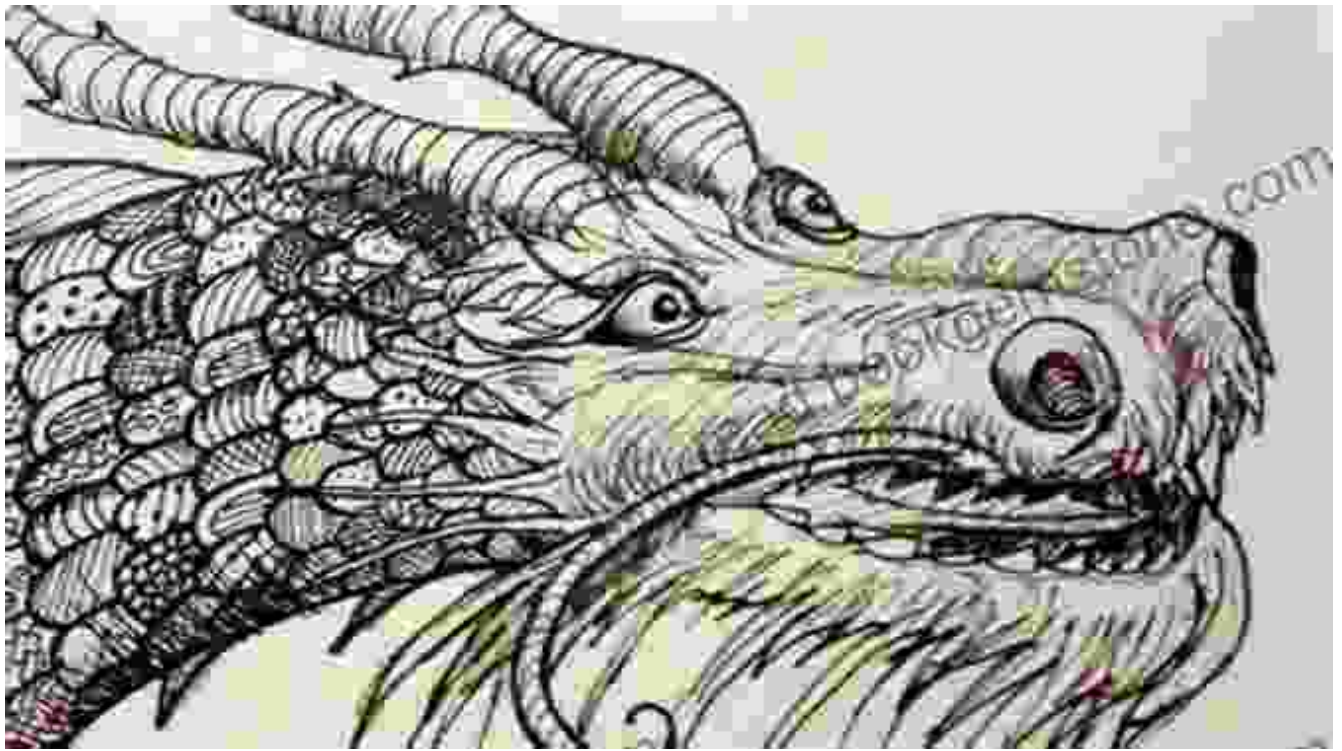
# How to Draw a Palm Tree

- 3.** Drawing several curved lines radiating from the top circle to represent the fronds.
- 4.** Refining the fronds into more defined, overlapping shapes.
- 5.** Further detailing the fronds and adding a small circle at the top to represent the trunk's connection to the crown.
- 6.** Adding more detail to the fronds and the trunk.
- 7.** Finalizing the line drawing of the palm tree.
- 8.** The final colored drawing of the palm tree, with a brown trunk and green fronds.

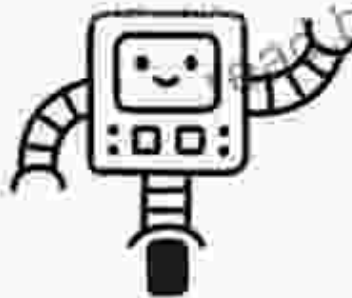
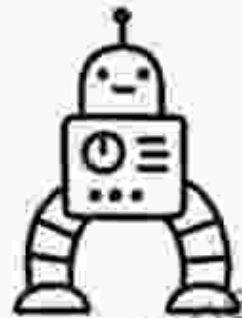
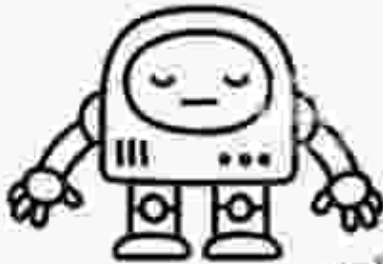
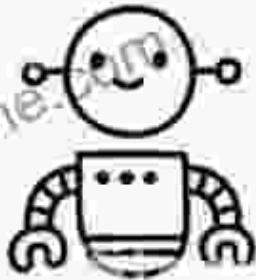
